## 3. COMPETITION EVENTS

### 3.1 TAOLU

#### 3.1.1 Individual Events

##### 3.1.1.1 Group A (Ages 16 to 17)

- The 1st Set of International Wushu Competition Routine: Changquan, Daoshu, Jianshu, Gunshu, Qiangshu; Nanquan, Nandao, Nangun; 24 steps Taijiquan, 32 steps Taijijian,

##### 3.1.1.2 Group B (Ages 13 to 15)

- 1st Set of International Wushu Competition Routine: Changquan, Daoshu, Jianshu, Gunshu, Qiangshu; Nanquan, Nandao, Nangun; 24 steps Taijiquan, 32 steps Taijijian

##### 3.1.1.3 Group C (Ages 12)

- Elementary Routine: Changquan (No. 3 Elementary Routine), Daoshu, Jianshu, Gunshu. Qiangshu; Elementary Nan Quan, Elementary Nan Dao, Elementary Nan Gun,

### 3.2 SANDA

#### 3.2.1 Weight Category

##### 3.2.1.1 Group A (Ages 16 to 17)

- Male: 48KG, 52KG; 56KG; 60KG; 65KG,70 KG  
Female: 48KG, 52KG; 56KG; 60KG; 65KG,

##### 3.2.1.2 Group B (Ages 13 to 15)

- Male: 42KG, 45KG, 48KG, 52KG, 56KG, 60KG;  
Female: 42KG, 45KG, 48KG, 52KG, 56 KG

## QUALIFICATIONS

Batang Pinoy is an open tournament for children aged 17 and under. According to the Batang Pinoy calendar for the year 2024, athletes must have been born in 2002 or later.

Participation is exclusively through accreditation by a Local Government Unit (LGU), which can be at the provincial, city, or municipal level. No athlete will be accepted without proper accreditation from a specific LGU. Each athlete is allowed to represent only one (1) LGU.

## 4 ENTRY REQUIREMENT

### 4.2 Taolu

4.2.1 Each team or Local Government Unit may enter a maximum of **TWO** participants per event.

4.2.2 Each athlete may enter a maximum of three events: **one barehand, one short weapon, and one long weapon.**

### 4.3 Sanda

4.3.1 Each team or Local Government Unit may sign-up one (1) competitor for each weight category, and each competitor is allowed to apply for only one (1) weight category.

## 5 COMPETITION METHOD

### 5.2 Taolu

5.2.1 The competition will be utilized the Non-Degree of Difficulty Scoring Method (comprising of A Group –Quality of Movements Scoring and B Group – Overall Performance Scoring only).

#### 5.2.2. Time limit:

5.2.1.1 Group A and B (Changquan, Daoshu, Jianshu, Gunshu, Qiangshu, Nanquan, Nandao and Nangun) no less than 1 minute 20 seconds.

5.2.1.2 Taijiquan, Taijijian is 3 minutes to 4 minutes

5.2.1.3 There is no time requirement for Elementary Taolu events.

### 5.3 Sanda

5.3.1 If the number of competitors in a weight category is three (3) persons, a single round-robin method will be adopted.

5.3.2 If only two or one athlete(s) registered in a weight category, the weight category will be cancelled.

5.3.3 Kicks to the head are prohibited.

## **6 COSTUMES & EQUIPMENTS**

### **6.2 Taolu**

- 6.2.1 Costumes worn and equipment used by competitor must comply with the rules during all events.
- 6.2.2 Competitors must prepare their own costumes and equipment.

### **6.3 Sanda**

- 6.3.1 Competitor must wear the costumes and protective gears in compliance with the rules during the competition.
- 6.3.2 Competitor must prepare their own, competition costumes and instep guard, one (1) set in red and one (1) set in blue.
- 6.3.3 Competitor must prepare their own mouth guard and jockstrap.
- 6.3.4 The gloves and protective equipment (head guard and chest protector) will be provided by the Organizing Committee.

## **7 PLACING & AWARDS**

### **7.2 Taolu**

- 1<sup>st</sup> place: Gold medal and Certificate
- 2<sup>nd</sup> place: Silver medal and Certificate
- 3<sup>rd</sup> place: Bronze medal and Certificate

### **7.3 Sanda**

- 1<sup>st</sup> place: Gold medal and Certificate
- 2<sup>nd</sup> place: Silver medal and Certificate
- 3<sup>rd</sup> place (juxtaposition): Bronze medal and Certificate

## **8 ENTRIES**

## **9 REGISTRATION & FINANCIAL CONDITIONS**

- 9.2 Designated billeting will be advised as soon as possible by the Philippine Sports Commission
- 9.3 Teams that wish to stay outside the provided billeting by the Philippine Sports Commission will be responsible for their own expenses.

## **10 COMPETITION MANAGEMENT**

10.2 The Wushu Federation of the Philippines Organizing Committee shall be responsible for the competition.

## **11 TECHNICAL MATTERS**

11.2 Each team may send representatives to attend the meeting during which matters concerning the competitions will be announced.

11.3 Events for the Group C category (16-17 years old) are exclusive to the 2023 Batang Pinoy. Therefore, in the subsequent Batang Pinoy events, we will be introducing the 3rd set International Competition Routine.

## **12 WEIGHT-IN**

12.2 Competitors will be disqualified if their weighing results do not meet the requirements of their reported weight class.

## **13 VICTORY CEREMONY**

13.2 The medalists are required to attend the Victory Ceremony.

13.3 The medalists must report to the designated place fifteen (15) minutes before the Victory Ceremony starts, and must wear their team official uniforms.

13.4 The medalists are not allowed to wear one-piece suits, gloves, hats, goggles, sunglasses, etc. to attend the award ceremony, and are not allowed to take any religious symbols to or onto the podium.

13.5 The medalists who are absent from the Victory ceremony without a valid reason will forfeit the right to receive a medal.

13.6 If fewer than three (3) medalists in a single event, no Victory Ceremony will be held for that event. The team leader will go to the designated place to receive medal and certificate.

## **14 OTHER MATTERS**

- 14.2 Each team must strictly abide by the rules and regulations of the competition and compete fairly.
- 14.3 Those who violate the regulations will be dealt with severely in accordance with the relevant regulations of the Wushu Federation of Philippines.
- 14.4 Each team must bring and submit the following items and information when reporting:
  - 14.4.1 Copy of PSA Birth Certificate
  - 14.4.2 Parent Consent.
  - 14.4.3 Athlete's medical certificate.
  - 14.4.4 Waiver of Medical Liability to be signed by the and LGU-accredited medical doctor.
  - 14.4.5 Signed Waiver of Liability by the participating team members.
  - 14.4.6 One final registration form.

**NOTE: Copy of Parent Consent, Waiver of Liabilities and Waiver of Medical Liability signed by medical doctor should be given at WFP representative during registration, before the official weigh in and draw lots.**
