25.9.6 ELIGIBILITY

- 25.9.6.1** The tournament is open to all Filipino chess players whose age is 12-17 years old (titled or untitled) representing their respective LGUs.
- 25.9.6.2** Each team (LGU) may be composed of 12 players for boys/men & 12 players for girls/women following a 2- player per age category (for Batang Pinoy Age Categories: (12AC, 13AC, U14AC, 15AC, 16 & 17AC).
- 25.9.6.3** Each player must be duly certified by the authorized LGU official that he/she represents. On-site registration will not be accepted.

25.9.7 COMPETITION FORMAT

The tournament will be conducted in nine (9) events.

25.9.7.1 Standard Chess.

- 25.9.7.1.1** Thirty (30) Minutes with thirty (30) seconds increment per move to finish the game.
- 25.9.7.1.2** Recording of moves in Algebraic Notation is mandatory.
- 25.9.7.1.3** Defaulting time is thirty (30) minutes (Running Time) after the official start of the game.
- 25.9.7.1.4** No offer of draw before the Black's 30th move.

25.9.7.2 Rapid Chess

15 Minutes with 5 seconds increment to finish the game.

25.9.7.3 Blitz Chess

3 Minutes with 2 seconds increment to finish the game.

25.9.7.4 Chess 960 Rapid

15 Minutes with 5 seconds increment to finish the game.

25.9.7.5 Chess 960 Blitz

3 Minutes with 2 seconds increment to finish the game.

25.9.7.6 ASEAN Chess Rapid

15 Minutes with 5 seconds increment to finish the game.

25.9.7.7 ASEAN Chess Blitz

3 Minutes with 2 seconds increment to finish the game.

15 Minutes with 5 seconds increment to finish the game.

25.9.9 COMPETITION RULES & REGULATIONS

25.9.9.1 The tournament shall be governed by the FIDE Laws of Chess.

25.9.9.2 The following tie break systems (in descending order of priority) shall be adopted to determine the final ranking:



25.9.9.2.1 INDIVIDUAL RESULTS

- 25.9.9.2.1.1** Direct Encounter
- 25.9.9.2.1.2** Buchholz Cut 1
- 25.9.9.2.1.3** Buchholz
- 25.9.9.2.1.4** S.B. System
- 25.9.9.2.1.5** The greater number of wins including forfeits
- 25.9.9.2.1.6** The greater number of wins with Black pieces

25.9.9.2.2 TEAM RESULTS

- 25.9.9.2.2.1** Combined Buchholz Cut 1 Tie Breaks of the members of the team
- 25.9.9.2.2.2** Combined Buchholz Tie Breaks of the members of the team
- 25.9.9.2.2.3** Combined S.B. Tie Breaks of the members of the team
- 25.9.9.2.2.4** Combined Number of Wins of the member of the team (forfeits counted)
- 25.9.9.2.2.5** Combined Number of Wins with Black Pieces of the member of the team (forfeits counted)

25.9.9.3 The use of mobile phones or any electronic means of communication is not allowed during a game. A player who will violate the aforementioned rule shall lose his/her game by forfeiture.

25.9.9.4 The starting rank of players shall be based on the latest FIDE Rating List.

25.9.9.5 Provisions

25.9.9.5.1 Tournament must be played in an air-conditioned venue.

25.9.9.5.2 The Host City must also provide the needed number of tables and chairs, a sound system for the venue, security and proper lighting for the venue.

25.9.9.5.3 The number of Technical Officials recommended by the National Chess Federation of the Philippines (NCFP) should be at least fifty (50) TOs.

25.9.9.5.4 The number of Local Arbiters / Volunteer Arbiters coming from the Host City will be determined by the number of registered participants.

25.9.10 AWARDS (FOR EACH CATEGORY)

25.9.10.1 Individual Medals will be awarded to the top three in each event and category.

25.9.10.2 Team Awards

25.9.10.2.1 Medals will be awarded to the top three (3) teams in each category and event.

25.9.10.2.2 Medals will be awarded based on the total scores of the two (2) players of an LGU.

25.9.10.3 Total number of medals for Individuals and Team Award: 396 medals

25.9.10.3.1 Gold – $84 + 24 + 24 = 132$

25.9.10.3.2 Silver – $84 + 24 + 24 = 132$
