Only Karate Pilipinas-licensed coaches will be permitted to coach during the Batang Pinoy 2025.

- **25.16.7.5.1** For teams whose coaches are currently unlicensed, Karate Pilipinas will offer a FREE seminar on the latest WKF competition rules, followed by a FREE accreditation exam.
- **25.16.7.5.2** Coaches who pass the accreditation will be allowed to accompany their athletes up to the coaches' box during the competition. Unlicensed coaches who do not take or fail the exam will be restricted to the bleachers area and will not be allowed to coach at ringside.

Please note: The accreditation license issued through this seminar is valid only for Batang Pinoy 2025 and does not serve as a regular Karate Pilipinas coaching license.

25.16.12 EQUIPMENT AND CLOTHING/UNIFORM

25.16.12.1 Uniform and Protective Gear

All participants are responsible for their own medical expenses and insurance coverage.

- 25.16.12.1.1 All Kumite participants are required to wear a gum shield (mouthguard).
- **25.16.12.1.2** All Kumite participants must wear body protectors that are approved by WKF or Karate Pilipinas.
- **25.16.12.1.3** All Kumite participants must use WKF or Karate Pilipinas approved red and blue shin and instep guards.
- **25.16.12.1.4** Only WKF or Karate Pilipinas approved red and blue mitts and belts (obi) may be used in competition.
- **25.16.12.1.5** All Kata and Kumite competitors must wear Aka or AO WKF or Karate Pilipinas approved uniforms only (karate gi).

Note: All of these requirements are mandatory. Violation of this rule will result in disqualification.
