



2022 BATANG PINOY WUSHU VIRTUAL CHAMPIONSHIPS REGULATIONS

1. Date: November 20-26, 2022

2. Place and Venue: Vigan, Ilocos Sur (Virtual)

3. Competition Events:

i. Group A- Ages (13-15)

1. Bare Hand – 1st Set Chang Quan; 1st Set Nan Quan; 24steps Taiji Quan
2. Short Weapon – 1stSet Dao Shu; 1st Set Jian Shu; 1st Set Nan Dao; 32 steps Taiji Jian
3. Long Weapon – 1st Set Cudgel; 1stSet Spear; 1st set Nan Gun

ii. Group B- Ages (7-12)

1. Bare Hand – Elementary Chang Quan (San Lu)
2. Short Weapon – Elementary Dao Shu; Elementary Jian Shu
3. Long Weapon – Elementary Cudgel; Elementary Spear

iii. Group C- Age (7-9) Novice

1. Bare Hand- Yi Lou Quan; Er Lou Quan

Time Limit:

- i. Group A: Not Less than 1min and 20sec. (bare hand, short weapon and long weapon event);
- ii. 24steps Taiji Quan and 32steps Taiji Jian - 3-4min.
- iii. Group B & C: No time Limit in all routine

4. Qualifications:

Batang Pinoy is an open tournament for children **15 years old and below** Based on the Batang Pinoy calendar year 2022..

Representation is strictly by Local Government Unit (LGU). This may be in the form of provincial, city and municipality. No athlete shall be accepted without accreditation of a particular LGU. Each athlete may represent only one (1) LGU.

5. Participation Methods:

- a) For Group A, B and C= each athlete may enter maximum three (3) events.
 1. **Bare Hand**
 2. **Short Weapon**
 3. **Long Weapon**
- b) Each team may enter a maximum of five (5) athletes per event.

6. Costumes and Equipments

- a) Competitor shall wear their own costume and prepare own equipment in compliance with the rule.

7. Placing of Awards:

- a) Top three (3) Boy and Girl will be awarded respectively with Medal and Certificate. (1-gold, 1-silver, 1-bronze)

8. Entries:

a. Preliminary Entry:

The Preliminary Entry from with the exact number of participants must reach the Secretariat by mail / e-mail or fax no later than 24:00 hrs (Manila Standard time)

9. Competition Management and Technical Official

- I. The WFP Organizing Committee shall be responsible for the competition.
- II. Medal Count
 - Less than 3 competitor per event will not be given medal as per Batang Pinoy 2022 Guidelines of PSC (<http://batangpinoy.psc.gov.ph/>)

10. Specific requirements for Video(s)

- I. To complete the registration, participants must fill in the registration form and upload the video(s). The video duration should not be less than the specified time, otherwise the content cannot be submitted. One participant is limited to compete in one event with one video, otherwise the submission will not be scored.
- II. The video should be continuously filmed, unedited and in high definition MP4 or MOV format, and it is recommended to make a video file less than 300MB. The footage should be clear and not shaky.
- III. The video should be customized for the competition. The competitor in the video can introduce the name of the competition and the event he/she participates in, or use a text label, background, banner or other markers for this purpose. If the video has been used for any other competition, the submission will not be scored.
- IV. It is strictly prohibited for competitors to resort to deceit or impersonation, and any competitors or participating teams violating such provisions, once verified, will be disqualified from the competition.
- V. It is prohibited for editing the submission and such conduct is considered as cheating and the submission will not be scored.
- VI. There are no rules for video recording scenes, indoor or outdoor recording, professional carpet or other venue recording.
- VII. The competitor or the participating team should be seen clearly in the footage, taking up 50% to 70% of the image.
- VIII. Loud noise should be avoided in the video.
- IX. The competitor in the video is recommended to avoid face covering if it is not against his/her local government guidelines on health protection.

- X. Please ensure the video is filmed in a well-lit environment so that the judges can see every movement clearly. If the submission is filmed in low-light conditions, it will not be scored.
- XI. Please film the video in landscape mode. Please use a tripod for stable filming. The filming is limited to camera panning. The camera height should be aligned with the head of the competitor and he/she should always stay in the image during the filming.
- XII. The submission should include the fist-and-palm salute prior to the routine, beginning the performance from a stationary position, stopping when his/her whole routine ends in a standing position and giving the fist-and-palm salute again. But it is strictly prohibited to buy time by greetings or other means.
- XIII. It is strictly prohibited to submit a video which violates social ethics, laws or regulations or uses product placement, including but not limited to images, pictures, icons, banners, slogans, wording and sounds.

13. Technical Matters;

Each team may send representatives to attend the meeting, at which matters concerning the competitions will be announced.

14. Other Matters:

- a. Each team shall strictly abide by the rules of the Organizing Committee and fairly.
- b. Those that violate the rules and regulation will be dealt with according to the regulation of the WFP.
- c. Each team is required to send the following to Wushu Federation Secretariat:
 - I. Copy of NSO Birth Certificate,
 - II. Parent Consent
 - III. Waiver of Liabilities
 - IV. Waiver of Medical Liability to be signed by the LGU representative or Coach and LGU-accredited medical doctor

****Copy of Parent Consent, Waiver of Liabilities and Waiver of Medical Liability signed by medical doctor should be given at WFP representative during registration, before the official weigh in and draw lots.**
