CYCLING – BMX Freestyle Flatland

Article 1. ORGANIZATION

- 1.1 The BMX Freestyle Flatland Cycling Competitions of the 2024 Batang Pinoy National Championships are organized by the Philippine Sports Commission (PSC).
- 1.2 The competitions are supervised by the Integrated Cycling Federation of the Philippines (PhilCycling), the national association of the sport recognized by the PSC and the Philippine Olympic Committee.

Article 2. EVENTS

2.1 Competitions will be for Boys and Girls in the 12-13, 14-15 and 16-17 age groups.

3.2 The **Start List** shall be announced after the License Check and Jersey, Bike Check on 22 November 2024.

Article 4. PARTICIPATION

- 4.1 Riders eligible to compete must represent a Local Government Unit (LGU)—either city or province.
- 4.2 LGUs shall register their athletes online through a Philippine Sports Commission (PSC)-designated portal and shall follow strictly PSC Batang Pinoy rules on registration.
- 4.3 Each LGU could enter a maximum of Two (2) Athletes per event and each athlete could compete in a maximum of Three (03) events in the Three disciplines combined—Road, MTB and BMX Freestyle Flatland.

Article 7. COMMISSAIRES & JUDGES PANEL

- 7.1 The Judges Panel from the PhilCycling shall be the deciding body during the conduct of the competition under strict compliance with International Cycling Union (UCI) rules and regulations.
- 7.2 The Judges Panel composed of three (3) member— the Head Judge together with two (2) other UCI-certified judges. The panel is assisted by the Project Manager and the Technical Delegate, they shall decide with finality on issues/concerns that may arise during the conduct of the competitions.

Article 8. MEDICAL SERVICE

8.1 Ambulance Units (Emergency Medical Team) shall be positioned in the following:

8.1.1 One (1) in the Field of Play all throughout the practice and competition proper,

8.2 A Medical Standby Team shall be provided at the Billeting Facilities for Athletes and Officials.

Article 13. START LIST AND HEAT BRACKETS

TBA – Upon receipt of final registration of competitors.

Article 14. MUSTERING AND SIGN ON

14.1 All riders must be present for Sign-on & Mustering One (01) Hour before the start of the competition.

Article 15. COMPETITION FORMAT

15.1 Heats per run: to be determined, will depend on the number of registrations per city/province.

15.2 Each rider is given two (2) runs.

15.3 Each run is 120 seconds (2 minutes) per rider.

15.4 Qualifying run is just one (1) run while Final run has two (2) runs.

Article 16. BICYCLES AND EQUIPMENT CONTROL

16.1 Standard BMX bikes shall be used in the competition, helmets are optional.

16.2 All riders must present their equipment for inspection by commissaires One (01) Hour before the start of competitions.

Article 17. JUDGING CRITERIA

17.1 Judging on overall impression according to latest UCI Rules and Regulation. The performance of each rider is judged on overall impression including, but not limited to:

- a. Difficulty / risk
- b. Flow / style
- c. Originality (tricks and lines) and versatility
- d. Consistency (refers the stability, fluidity and control of maneuvers performed)
- e. Variety of tricks
- f. Control of the tricks
- g. Bike control
- h. Execution

17.2 The overall composition of the runs is most important as the judges evaluate the sequences of tricks, the amount of risk in the routine, and how the rider uses the course. The judges take errors such as falls, stops, and foot touching the ground into consideration.

Article 18. UCI RULE BOOK

Article 19. SCORING

19.1 Qualification Run (will depend on the number of registrations)
2 runs. Both runs count, average score for both runs.
Qualifier Selection: Top 12 athletes to be selected from qualifiers

19.2 Final Run
2 runs each rider for 120 seconds each. Scores will be averaged.

19.3 Scoring System
Criteria for Judging is based on the UCI Rule Book (Part 6, Chapter VI)
Each run is scored from 40 to 100
DNS – Did not Start, DNF – Did not Finish, DQ – Disqualified

Article 20. ANTI-DOPING

20.1 Doping controls are according to the UCI regulations and will be announced.

Article 21. CLOTHING

21.1 Clothing shall only be UCI-regulation—jerseys, shirts, pants, shorts are allowed. Helmets are optional. Unauthorized clothing or apparel is forbidden.

Article 22. AWARDS CEREMONIES AND MEDIA INTERVIEWS

22.1 The 1st, 2nd and 3rd placers shall be awarded the gold, silver and bronze medals.

22.2 The Medal Ceremony shall take place 30 minutes after the last event of each competition day on 16 November 2024.

22.3 The Top 3 placers shall make themselves immediately available for the Medal Ceremony and shall wear their complete team jerseys only without any head gear (caps, hats, etc.) Fines shall be slapped on the teams and coaches whose athletes are not available during the medal ceremony.

22.3 All riders/cyclists specially the Top 3 placers in all events and categories shall make themselves available for media interviews.

Article 23. PENALTIES

23.1 Penalties shall be applied in accordance with the UCI regulations.

Article 24. WASTE DISPOSAL

24.1 Riders caught throwing empty bottles, peels, trash or any garbage shall will be automatically disqualified. Coaches and team officials and staff caught littering shall be fined.

Article 25. PROTESTS

25.1 Protests shall be in written form and filed within 30 minutes after the results have been posted and with a corresponding fee (amount of fee TBA) to be filed with the Philippine Sports Commission and Batang Pinoy Secretariat. All protests will be decided on site by the Panel of Commissaires.

Article 26. RESPONSIBILITIES

26.1 The PhilCycling shall not, under any circumstances, be liable to any accidents or damage that occurs during training and competitions.

26.2 Untoward incidents and their corresponding costs shall be the responsibility of the Philippine Sports Commission.

26.3 For all cases not covered by these specific regulations, the UCI rules will apply.

Article 1. ORGANIZATION

- 1.1 The Road Cycling Competitions of the 2024 Batang Pinoy National Championships are organized by the Philippine Sports Commission (PSC).
- 1.2 The competitions are supervised by the Integrated Cycling Federation of the Philippines (PhilCycling), the national association of the sport recognized by the PSC and the Philippine Olympic Committee.

Article 2. EVENTS

2.1 Competitions will be for Boys and Girls in the 12-13, 14-15 and 16-17 age groups.

Article 12. MUSTERING AN4 SIGN ON

12.1 All riders/cyclists must present themselves for Sign On and Mustering One (01) Hour before the start of each event.

Article 13. STARTING ORDER IN ITT and START PROCEDURE FOR INDIVIDUAL ROAD RACE

13. 1 The starting order for the Individual Time Trial (ITT) races shall be composed by the commissaires and communicated through various media platforms utilized by the Philippine Sports Commission and PhilCycling.

13. 2 In the ITT, the start interval will be One (01) minute.

Article 14. BICYCLES AND EQUIPMENT CONTROL

14.1 Standard Road Bikes shall be used in all categories and events, including in the Individual Time Trial (ITT) with the option to use of Aero Bars, but aero helmets are not permitted.

14.2 All riders/cyclists must present their equipment for inspection by commissaires One (01) Hour before the start of competitions.

Article 15. NEUTRAL TECHNICAL SUPPORT

15.1 Technical support shall be provided by Three (03) neutral vehicles only during the Individual Road Race.

Article 16. FEEDING AND TEAM SUPPORT

16.1 Feeding shall be allowed at a designated pit during the Criterium Races.

16.2 There shall be no feeding during ITT races.

16.3 Stationary hydration/feed stations will be situated in specified sections during the Individual Road Races.

16.4 Team support for Technical Assistance/Recognized Mishaps/Mechanical Issues shall be at a designated location during the Criterium Races.

16.5 Team support on motorcycles are not allowed in all of the races except for recognized mishaps or mechanical issues.

Article 17. CURFEW

17.1 Time limit for Individual Road Races is 10 percent.

Article 18. ANTI-DOPING

18.1 Doping controls according to UCI regulations will be announced.

Article 19. CLOTHING

19.1 Clothing shall only be UCI-regulation—jerseys, shorts and socks (must not exceed the halfway mark between the edge of the ankles and the bottom of the knees). Regulation helmets are mandatory. Unauthorized clothing or apparel is forbidden.

Article 20. AWARDS CEREMONIES AND MEDIA INTERVIEWS

20.1 The 1st, 2nd and 3rd placers shall be awarded the gold, silver and bronze medals.

20.2 The Medal Ceremony shall take place 30 minutes after the last event of each competition day on 25, 26 and 27 November 2024.

20.3 The Top 3 placers shall make themselves immediately available for the Medal Ceremony and shall wear their complete team jerseys only. Penalties shall be slapped on the teams and coaches whose athletes are not available during the medal ceremony.

20.4 All riders/cyclists specially the Top 3 placers in all events and categories shall make themselves available for media interviews.

Article 21. PENALTIES

22.1 Penalties shall be applied in accordance with the UCI regulations.

Article 22. WASTE DISPOSAL

22.1 Riders caught throwing empty bottles, peels or any form of trash shall be disqualified. Coaches and team officials and staff caught littering shall be penalized.

Article 23. PROTESTS

23.1 Protests shall be in written form and filed within 30 minutes to the Commissaires Panel after the first rider has crossed the finish line. (See PSC-Batang Pinoy Policy on the Filing of Protests).

23.2 Protests on Technical/Race Concerns will be decided on site by the Panel of Commissaires.

Article 24. RESPONSIBILITIES

24.1 The PhilCycling shall not, under any circumstances, be liable to any accidents or damage that occurs during training and competitions.

24.2 Untoward incidents and their corresponding costs shall be the responsibility of the Philippine Sports Commission.

24.3 For all cases not covered by these specific regulations, the UCI rules will apply.
